NICENE CREED

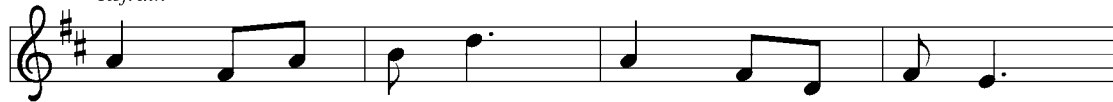
