

It is now up to Church Council. We discussed salary for each. We came to a consensus of approximately \$40,000 per year plus two weeks vacation for Ro. For Angela it is \$50,000 to \$52,000 with three weeks vacation. Angela is basically a new pastor and Ro has many years of experience.
